Grand Knight's Message

February is known as the month of LOVE. Jesus said in John 13:35 "This is the way they will know you are my disciples, if you love one another". As brother Knights, we must strive to be better husbands, fathers, men and friends. We must learn to love better!

Dr. Gary Chapman, a well-known marriage councillor had seen a pattern developing over many years of counselling couples. He discovered what makes one person feel love does not necessarily make another person feel love.

He had a couple in his office he was counselling that had been married 30 years. The wife felt that her husband didn't love her. The husband said "I cook the meals every night, do the dishes, help clean the house and cut the lawn. I do all these things to show her how much I love her, and she keeps saying she doesn't feel love, I don't know what else to do". The wife then said, "He's right, he is a hardworking man, but we haven't really talked in 30 years". A sincere husband, who is loving his wife in the best way he knows how, and a wife that didn't get it.

Dr. Chapman had seen this time and time again. He would have a couple in his office where both loved each other, but just are not communicating with each other. He poured though his notes he had taken over 12 years of counselling and found 5 different "love languages" that people speak.

- 1. Words of affirmation- using positive words to affirm the other person "you look great, you are doing a great job, you are a great cook"
- 2. Gifts some need to receive gifts. They don't need to be expensive. I have received many trinkets that I have received from my kids, that I will cherish forever.
- 3. Acts of Service Do something to show your love. Washing dishes, house cleaning, cooking.
- 4. Spending Quality Time Giving someone your undivided attention. Could be a walk together, date night or sitting together.
- 5. Physical Touch Long before babies understand the word love, they have experienced it with hugs kissing and cuddles.

He found that everyone has a primary love language. One of the 5 speaks more deeply than the other 4. We can receive love in all 5 languages, but there is usually one that speaks stronger to our hearts.

Dr. Chapman found that in a marriage, rarely couples have the same love language. If your language is Acts of Service, you will be "busy" doing many things to show your wife you love her. If her language is Words of Affirmation, she will not see your "acts of service" as love and may not feel love since she is needing to hear your words.




