# Notice of Motion

At the general meeting in April, a discussion regarding the meeting nights was held. In November, 2023, a notice of motion to change the meeting nights to Tuesdays was put forth and the by-law was changed to read:

Currently Article IV – Meetings - Section 1. states that "The first monthly business meeting of the Council shall be held on the first Tuesday of the month and the second monthly meeting shall be held on the third Tuesday of the month. The meetings shall be held at such time and place as the Council may designate."

Members who regularly attend our meetings noted that the changes that were made were intended to accommodate members who were unable to attend meetings on Thursdays. To date, attendance at Tuesday meetings remains the same, hence, a notice of motion to change the meeting nights back to Thursdays was put forth. This by-law change requires the following notice of motion:

Motion: That Article IV- Meetings - Section 1. be amended to read "That the first monthly business meeting of the Council shall be held on the first Thursday of the month and the second monthly meeting shall be held on the third Thursday of the month. The meetings shall be held at such time and place as the Council may designate."

By Br. Barry Lehmann, seconded by Br. Paul Shutsa. Carried

Article IX – Miscellaneous - Section 1. states that "These By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at a regular business meeting held subsequent to a regular business meeting at which a resolution in writing providing for such amendment shall have been read and notice of the proposed amendment shall have been given to the members in writing or in the council publication at least five days prior to the second meeting."

As required by Council 8192 by-laws, notice is hereby given that a vote to amend by-law Article IV- Meetings - Section 1. as stated above, will be presented at the May General Meeting and voted on at the <u>June General Meeting</u> on **June 18, 2024**. A two-thirds majority vote will successfully amend our meeting nights from Tuesday to Thursday. Should this amendment be successful, our September meetings will change from September 3 and September 17 to September 5 and September 19.
